SUPER BOWL DOUBLES 9-PIN NO TAP CHARITY TOURNAMENT
February 10th, 2024 at Riverside Lanes

Entry into this tournament is open to all adults, no USBC membership required. Subject to lane availability, **entries will close 10 minutes before the start of the tournament.** No refunds once tournament begins. Bowlers will trade pairs after 2 games (for example: lanes 1 & 2 will swap with lanes 3 & 4, lanes 5 & 6 will swap with 7 & 8, and so forth down the center).

ENTERING AVERAGES: Entrants will use their highest certified current league average of 21 games or more as of January 19, 2020. **It is the responsibility of the individual bowler to furnish the appropriate standing sheet from their league and/or leagues to verify their current high average. If an entrant fails to furnish an appropriate league standing sheet at check-in, they will be assigned an average of 230.**

Handicap: Will be based on 90% of 230 for men and women.

Doubles may consist of the following combinations: 2 men, 2 women, or 1 man and 1 woman.

Entry Fee: Lineage:	\$16.00
Prize Fund:	\$13.00
Charity Donation:	\$11.00
Total Per Bowler:	\$40.00

Awards: Estimated prizes shall be at least 1:5 entries. **All prize money collected will be returned 100% to participants in the tournament.** In the event of a tie, co-champions will be declared and no roll off will occur.

Scoring: The tournament will be conducted in a 9-pin no-tap format. In this format a bowler will get credit for a strike when knocking down 9 pins on the first ball. The bowler will not attempt the spare and the frame will be completed. Bowlers will not get credit for spares having knocked down only 9 pins.

Mulligans: With a pre-set additional charitable donation, bowlers in this tournament will be allowed to enhance their score via a mulligan, or a second attempt at a frame. Mulligans will be limited to (1) frame per game per bowler, purchased before bowling begins, they are non-refundable and non-transferable and must be declared to a tournament official immediately after the first ball frame that they are being used on.

All other rules will be based on the 2023-2024 USBC Rulebook

All net proceeds from this tournament will be donated to the Skagit Valley Hospital Cancer Patient Fund and its recipients. This fund goes to directly impact the lives of patients who are currently battling cancer by providing things such as gas or transportation to get them to their appointments, money for groceries as many of them are not able to work while undergoing treatment, and help fund their ongoing medical expenses.
